

# CHATEAU LA PRADE 2003

## BORDEAUX COTES DE FRANCS

This is a 10-acre property situated on a limestone and clay plateau as well as hillsides. The vineyard is planted with 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. In a hot year such as 2003, this property can excel. The 2003 La Prade exhibits a deep purple color in addition to a sweet nose and flavours of blueberries, black currants, crushed rocks, chocolate, and subtle wood. This deep, medium to full-bodied, impressively endowed effort will drink well for 7-8 years.
